

Group booking agreement

The group lead must read and sign this form at their earliest convenience, no later than 2 days before the date of the booking. We may have to cancel your booking if the following agreement is not completed.

Large groups are very welcome at Mountpanther and we cater towards all sorts of group visits including youth clubs, summer schemes, disabled groups, mum and toddler groups and many more.

We have certain rules in place for larger groups to ensure the health and safety of all children in the group, as well as other patrons in the park.

The following rules apply for groups with 20 children or more:

- All children in the park must be supervised by a parent or guardian, in the case of group bookings this means that appropriate supervision MUST be provided and a suitable adult: child ratio.

The following ratio is recommended by the Education Authority for educational trips:

- Foundation Stage (P1/P2) one adult for up to a maximum of ten young people.
- Key Stages 1 and 2 (P3-P7) one adult for up to a maximum of fifteen young people.

(If you cannot meet the above ratio, please contact us as we may have to amend your booking.)

- Your group will be required to split into smaller groups when exploring the park, as our areas cannot handle mass amounts of people at one time e.g. inflatables, play areas and our petting barn. Maximum group size is 20 kids in one area. The groups can then be rotated accordingly.
- You must establish a rendezvous point for your group (E.g. one of our fire assembly points) and inform all members of the group where this is and instruct them to go to this point if they are lost.
- All children in the group must wear something identifiable so that our staff and group leaders can easily identify all children that are with the group. (ie. T-shirt, wristband, badge, sticker, hat etc).
